

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What should I expect if attending the annual meeting for the first time?

The CJP annual Convention is THE premier aircraft owner meeting in the world. You will be impressed with the quality of the seminars, tours, social events and organization of the total event. Every little detail is well planned in advance and those that attend the meeting almost always return. Both the pilots and companions make many new friendships at the conventions.

What does the registration fee cover?

The registration fee covers all food from Wednesday night through Saturday at 3:00pm. It also includes transportation during the official arrival and departure times, gifts, seminars, etc. You should not have any extra expenses except your room and shopping.

Do I have to pay for my spouse/companion or guests?

This year the CJP board of directors has lowered the price for a spouse/companion. This registration rate is limited to one Companion/Spouse per paid owner registrant and is limited to a companion or spouse that resides in the same household as the primary registrant. Additional guests can be registered at the regular rate. The majority of the money spent on the CJP Annual Meeting is for food, transportation, etc., therefore everyone must pay a registration fee.

Do I have to pay the full registration fee if I can only attend a day or two?

Yes. There are many costs that are incurred whether someone attends for one day or the entire Convention. As such, we have just one registration fee.

What if I have to cancel after registering?

Registrations are 100% refundable if you cancel before September 4th. After September 4th there will be no refunds.

Do I need to rent a car for the convention?

Normally, no. Free transportation is provided to/from the airport FBO and The Arizona Biltmore on Tuesday & Wednesday (11:00-7:00), and on Sunday (6:30-12:00). If you arrive or depart outside of those windows, your options are to get a taxi, Uber or rent a car.

When is the best time to arrive & depart the convention?

You should arrive at the convention no later than Wednesday at 4:30 p.m. if you wish to make all the seminars and events. You should depart any time on Sunday, October 8.

Will my companion have planned activities?

CJP is a very active proponent of companion activities. The companions attending the convention have many activities to choose from. We are offering a companions ground school and the option for a 2 hour companions flying training session in your plane (see page 10). Please look at Page 11 in this brochure for the companions suggested highlights. CJP has also planned a companions get acquainted luncheon. Also please stay tuned as CJP is planning on adding more companion events as plans are finalized.

What is the dress code for the convention?

- The Thursday evening party will be hosted by Textron Aviation and is casual.
- Friday Auction Dinner: Though not required, many gentlemen will either wear a jacket or suit, and most ladies will prefer a cocktail dress.
- All other Convention events are country club casual.
